

## Description

This stone-built link detached family home extends to circa 2200 ft.<sup>2</sup> and offers updated accommodation, briefly comprises an entrance boot room, leading into a cozy lounge with a log-burning stove. Recently fitted kitchen with high-quality units and space large enough for a family dining table. Adjoining is a separate useful utility area with a side access door. An inner hall off the lounge area opens to a bright and airy extended sitting/dining room with velux windows and patio doors leading out onto the cottage garden. This room could be utilised as a ground floor bedroom for a dependent relative as there is a fully tiled shower room just across the hallway. On the first floor, from a central landing, are four double bedrooms and a house bathroom with a large airing cupboard.

Outside there is a private driveway providing hardstanding for two cars leading to a single garage, which houses the biomass boiler. The cottage garden offers superb long distance Nidderdale views. There are approximately 2.5 acres of land presenting numerous opportunities for self-sufficient living. It's ideal for those interested in sustainable practices, such as growing their own produce, raising small livestock, or creating wildlife-friendly habitats. The space is also perfect for nature enthusiasts who enjoy birdwatching, observing local wildlife, or simply preserving and nurturing the natural environment. There is a main water supply to the lower and upper areas of the land.

Reynard Crag provides something for everybody and particularly those looking to get away to a peaceful, scenic location only 15 minutes away from Harrogate.
